Pen-y-ghent: The First Ascent

Leaving Horton-in-Ribblesdale, the route winds through fields before rising steadily towards the unmistakable profile of Pen-y-ghent. The final climb steepens, rewarding efforts with big views from the summit trig point. A zig-zag descent passes dramatic limestone features, setting the tone for the challenge ahead.



Whernside: The Long Climb

A gentler stretch leads past farms, tracks and the iconic Ribblehead Viaduct before the route turns uphill again. The ascent to Whernside is gradual but relentless, climbing onto a broad ridge that delivers sweeping views from Yorkshire's highest peak.

Ingleborough: The Final Push

After descending to the valley, the path crosses limestone pavements before steepening onto Ingleborough's wide summit plateau. The final descent drops through Sulber Nick and open fields, guiding you back to Horton. Tired legs, big smiles, and a powerful sense of achievement.
